Fill in the blanks with the past tense of the given verbs,
then use your dictionary to translate the sentences.

1. Else **lyttede** til musik, mens Jesper **vaskede** op. (lytter, vasker).

Else listened to music while Jesper washed the dishes.

2. Vi **snakkede** i telefon og **talte** igen på bibliotek. (snakke, tale)

We chatted on the telephone and spoke again at the library.

3. De **skrev** et brev og **fortalte** os om deres ferie. (skrive, fortælle)

They wrote a letter and told us about their vacation.

4. Jeg **gik** hjem, men Annette **kørte** hjem. (gå, køre)

I went home, but Annette drove home.

5. Vores kor **sang** Händels Messias og min mor **spillede** orgel. (synde, spille)

Our choir sang Händel's Messiah and my mom played (the) organ.

6. Han **stod** der og **sagde** han **elskede** mig! (stå, sige, elske)

He stood there and said he loved me!

7. Hun **så** mig, da (when) jeg **var** i skole. (se, være)

She saw me when I was in school.

8. De **spurgte** mig om (if) I **hjælp** Anne i går. (spørge, hjælpe)

They asked me if I helped Anne yesterday.

9. **Vidste** du ikke, hun **ønskede** sig* en ny cykel? (vide, ønske)

Knew you not (didn't you know) she wanted a new bicycle?

* sig [pronounced “sigh”] is part of a reflexive verb, meaning – in this sentence – *for herself*.
